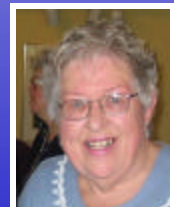

What is CFUW?

Canadian Federation of University Women - Oakville, a member of CFUW and IFUW, is an organization of women graduates committed to:

- Promote the pursuit of knowledge and education
- Participate in public affairs
- Provide opportunity for fellowship, support and networking
- Provide scholarships to women in the community

Founded in 1919, CFUW is a voluntary, non-partisan, non-profit, self-funded organization of over 10,000 women across Canada. Members are active in public affairs, working to raise the social, economic and legal status of women and girls, as well as to improve education, the environment, peace, justice and human rights.

CFUW is the second largest of the 78 national affiliates of the International Federation of University Women (IFUW), which has accreditation with the United Nations.

CLUB ACTIVITIES

CFUW - Oakville's activities kick-off in September each year, running through May.

Speakers & General Meetings - The 3rd Monday of each month is the club's General Meeting featuring internationally known speakers. After an hour of social time, the business meeting includes a dynamic speaker and discussion of club business, such as advocacy or fundraising for scholarships.
