

What is CFUW?

The Canadian Federation of University Women - Oakville, a member of CFUW and the International Federation of University Women (IFUW), is an organization of women graduates committed to:

- promote the pursuit of knowledge and education;
- participate in public affairs;
- provide opportunity for fellowship, support and networking; and,
- provide scholarships to women in the community.

Founded in 1919, CFUW is a volunteer, non-partisan, non-profit, self-funded organization of over 10,000 women across Canada. Members are provided with opportunities to participate in public affairs — working to raise the social, economic and legal status of women and girls — as well as improving education, the environment, peace, justice, and human rights.

CFUW is the second largest of the over 75 national affiliates of IFUW, which has accreditation with the United Nations, and is the largest voting affiliate.

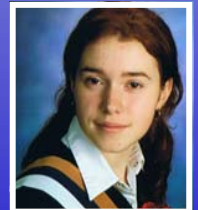

Awards

Each year, CFUW-Oakville presents awards to Oakville women graduating from publicly-funded schools who are enrolled in full-time studies at post-secondary institutions. These awards are funded by the University Women's Club of Oakville Scholarship Fund.

University Entrance Awards

CFUW Oakville University Entrance awards – for be Honours students with solid references, who would benefit from the financial assistance the awards provide.

Mildred G. Allworth Scholarship – awarded to the highest academically ranked recipient.

Community Service awards:

Jean Malcolm Smith Award – to recognize outstanding service to the school and community.

In Memory of Shirley Henderson – stipulates financial need in addition to community service.

CFUW Oakville Community Service– stipulates financial need in addition to community service.

Performing Arts Awards:

In Memory of Eleanore Stone – considers all performing arts and is designed to assist a young woman who is pursuing post-secondary education in music, drama or dance.

Mature Student Award:

CFUW Mature Student Award — considers mature students who are upgrading their qualifications or pursuing a career change at college or university. Outstanding academic achievement and financial need are considered.

About the Fund

The University Women's Club of Oakville Scholarship Fund was established in 1988, with the objective to advance and promote the education of women through the provision of scholarships. All monies are used solely for promoting this objective.

The Fund is a registered charity. Tax receipts are issued for donations, including the portion of each member's annual fees that are designated for the Scholarship Fund.
